INTRODUCTION

Many aspects of the Fiji National Strategic Plan (2009 – 2011) and the Pacific Regional Strategic plan (2009 – 2013), require partnerships with agencies across the health and community sector and across health service boundaries. These strategies focus on working with vulnerable communities, who may be at risk of HIV infection, as well as the public and private health care systems to scale up their capacity in prevention, treatment, care and management of HIV and other STIs.

The Fiji School of Medicine (FSMed), Fiji in collaboration with the Albion Street Centre (ASC), Australia is currently implementing the “Pacific Health Care Work force Development Project – (Sexual Health).” This is a three (3) year project that started in July 2008 and that aims to strengthen the capacity of FSMed to train health care workers (HCW) to provide integrated and responsive sexual health services in Fiji and other pacific island countries and territories. The mechanisms for capacity building in this project include: building partnerships between FSMed and other health care training schools in Fiji and other Pacific regional countries; vulnerable communities (through their representative groups) including sex workers; men who sex with men (MSM); youths and people living with HIV (PLHIV); engaging vulnerable groups in the development and implementation of relevant aspects of sexual health training; increasing access to training for both HCW and students of the health professions at FSMed; and development of, and access to, mentoring and peer support programs for HCW providing sexual health services.

In order to support these strategic plans, information on current training opportunities for HCW, representative groups and other community based organizations (CBO) working in sexual health/STIs/HIV in Fiji and the Pacific region was compiled. The information includes relevant training opportunities in Australia and New Zealand to assist those Pacific HCW and students who may be gaining experience and knowledge of health care in overseas settings.

The directory is organized into two parts:

Part I contains general information about the organizations, contact details for enquiries and a link to the website (if one exists) where additional information and details on upcoming training opportunities can be found.

Part II presents general information on HIV and AIDS funding agencies and scholarships in the region.

HOW THE DIRECTORY SHOULD BE USED

The directory can be used in a variety of ways:

- It can be used by organizations to review up coming STI and HIV training opportunities in the region in order to plan professional development activities for staff
- It can be used by Researchers and students as a link for their research related work
- Staff can use it for establishing networks with different organizations involved in program planning and training in STI and HIV in the region
- Organizations (including representative groups and CBOs) can use it as a starting point to secure scholarships, funding support and partnerships with specialised STI and HIV training organizations.
